LTTA - LEARNING, TRAINING AND TEACHING ACTIVITY

From 23 to 27 November, the invited lecturers from Bulgaria and Greece stayed in Prague, and from Wednesday to Friday, colleagues from Germany and Romania were virtually present with them. The pandemic situation negatively affected the meeting, it had to be solved in a hybrid way, but on the other hand, thanks to this we could try out the hybrid form of teaching ourselves.

On Wednesday and Thursday from 9 am to 4 pm the participants listened, viewed, and worked with the materials in all four learning scenarios - Algae, BBE, Biogas, and Bio-packaging. Friday was dedicated to the issue of strengthening personal and transversal competences, discussing different teaching methods and tools to make learning in this area as interesting as possible.

Thanks to this activity, we gained a lot of interesting remarks that we plan to include in our teaching materials and in the prepared pedagogical manual to make our outputs as good as possible. We, therefore, continue to accept all comments and welcome them.

Further planning

In the coming months, each partner will organize so-called National Multiplier Events. At these events, all project results will be presented and discussed. You will be informed about the place and date by your partner organization as well.
