Biocomp project goes to final.

As the rest of you know, we are working with a large partner team from eight EU countries to identify the most important competences in selected areas of the bio-economy and to develop learning scenarios to improve them.

The learning materials were created, consulted with experts, teachers, tested on a group of potential trainers, and used in education. The final versions are available on our web pages <https://navigator.biocompetences.eu>. Now they've been presented to the public in multiplier events!

ME – MULTIPLIER EVENT

MULTIPLIER EVENTS were held in February or March in Bulgaria, Czechia, Germany, Greece, and Romania in the form of a national launch to ensure that the projects' intellectual outputs are promoted to as wide an audience as possible. Each partner led the event in their own country and OEC will carry out an international event at the end of March in Brussels, tapping into its extensive transnational networks.

The events had the same structure. After the Initial plenary session to introduce the BioComp motivation and concept the brief introduction of Intellectual outputs (IOs) was continued. The most important were smaller breakout working sessions, organised to facilitate "hands-on" use of the IOs according to the specific interests of each attendee. In the end, a final plenary session reviewed the work and opinions of the breakout groups. Networking opportunities were scheduled at coffee breaks and lunch.

The participants were asked for feedback which will be reviewed at the final partner meeting and will form a valuable component of the sustainability plan and internal and external evaluation processes. The first analysis shows that materials are considered useful, modern, and interesting.

Further planning

We plan to finish our project in April 2022. The Final transnational meeting and Multiplier Event, both in Brussels, will help us to finalize the project to the best benefit and sustainability.
